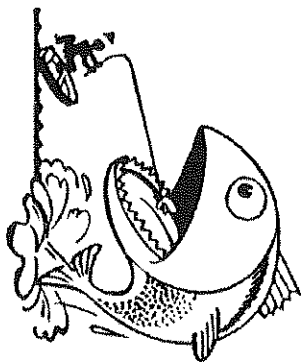

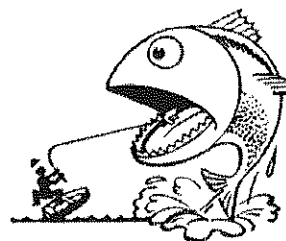

RULES

1. Horsepower must not exceed U.S. Coast Guard rating.
2. Safe boating conduct must be observed at all times. Each competitor is required to have a Coast Guard approved chest-type life preserver which must be worn and strapped, snapped, or zippered any time the combustion engine is operating.
3. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages permitted during the tournament.
4. Artificial Bait only. No live bait will be permitted with the exception of pork baits (rinds, strips, etc.) Only one casting, spincasting, or spinning rod and reel may be used at any one time. All bass must be caught live and in a conventional sporting manner. Trolling is prohibited.
5. Boats will not fish closer than 50 yards of an anchored boat.
6. Every boat must be a minimum of 12 feet in length and have a working livewell or aerated cooler. No stringers or live baskets allowed. Kill switch is recommended.
7. Only largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass, 12 inches or longer, are considered legal for the tournament. Limit is 5 fish per team/boat.
8. During tournament hours it will be illegal to leave your boats. If you must leave the boat, go to the starting point and notify an official to remain qualified.
9. Tournament winner will be determined by total weight of tournament fish weighed. A 1/2 pound penalty for each dead bass and disqualification for each undersize fish brought to the scale will be assessed. Ties will be broken by the largest number of fish, then flip a coin.
10. A contestant who is late for check-in will be disqualified.
11. Fish length will be measured from the tip of the snout to the end of the tail with the fish laid flat, mouth closed, and tail lobes pressed together.
12. Tournament officials shall have the right to board any participating boat and inspect reels, livewells, baits, and equipment. All boats shall be inspected prior to launch. Complaints about participants, made in writing within 30 minutes of weigh-in, shall be immediately investigated.
13. Completion of application and payment of entry fee certifies that I have read the Official Tournament Rules and agree to waive all responsibility on the part of any tournament participant, official, or host as to injury and for damage which might occur in connection with this tournament.
14. Violation of these rules, cheating, or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification. The decision of the tournament committee will be final and binding.
15. ALL STATE LAWS APPLY.

GENERAL INFORMATION

One man or two men per boat can be considered a team for the tournament. Flight consisting of 25 boats will be sent off at 15 minute intervals starting at 7:00 a.m. and each flight will have a full 8 hours to fish. There will be no blast off. Early entrants will be notified of their starting position by return mail to the person listed as the boat owner.

Late entrants will be notified the day of the tournament. Flight assignments will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, with the postmark date as a determining factor. Registration the day of the tournament will be from 5:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Boat inspection will be at the East Shore Ramp at 5:30 a.m.
