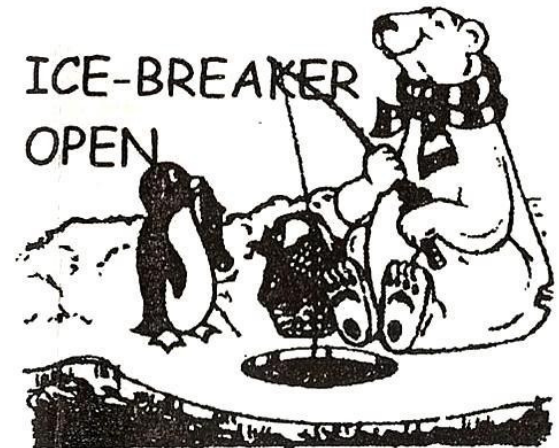

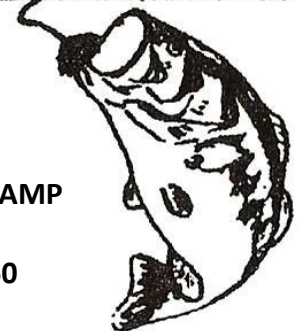

### RULES:

1. All boats must start from the **Moundwood Boat Ramp** launching area. Other ramps may be used for access. Assistance and live-well check will begin at 5:30 AM tournament day.
2. Tournament hours are 7:30 AM to 3:30 PM. Flights may be assigned depending on the number of entries. Times will be adjusted accordingly. Late arrivals to weigh-in will be disqualified.
3. There is a five-bass limit per boat. This is a team event; any contestant fishing alone will be considered a "team."
4. All contestants must wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved life vest while gas motor is running.
5. All state and local laws must be observed. Any rules violations must be reported to tournament officials before cash prizes are awarded.
6. Horsepower is limited to BIA plate ratings for each boat.
7. No trolling allowed. Only artificial baits may be used. All fish must be caught in a sportsman-like manner.
8. Ties will be decided by total number of fish alive and then by coin flip.
9. Keep your catch alive. All live wells must work properly. A .25 pound penalty will be given for each dead bass. All bass will be released alive back into the lake.
10. Any bass less than 12 inches brought to the scales will result in a 1 pound penalty.
11. Decisions of the Tournament Director are final.

Entries by mail must be sent prior to March 27th. Boat positions will be assigned based on the date of the post mark.

Entries will be accepted at the launch site on Friday evening prior to the tournament between 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. and on tournament day beginning at 5:30 a.m. Boat positions will be assigned as entries are received.
