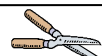

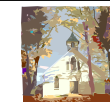
### Yard Work & Odd Jobs Needed

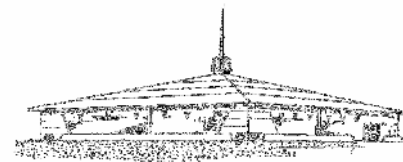
