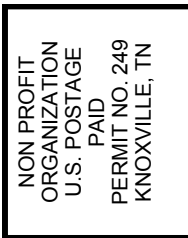

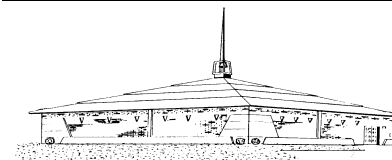

"Building Fund"

Since the loan on the Ministry Center was paid off last summer, a number of people have asked what the "Building Fund" is for now. Some have continued to give; others have been reluctant to give without any clear sense of the use of the fund. One area of pressing needs in relation to our Building is the Sanctuary. The sound system is in need of upgrading, and the projectors are nearing the end of their life expectancy. It is our hope that both of these important improvements can be accomplished for approximately \$20,000. At the July 27 Business Meeting, the church voted to use the building fund and moneys that are designated to the building fund to complete this task. There is currently about \$11,000 in the fund. The replacement of the projectors has already been arranged and will be completed soon. As the funds are given, and upon final approval of the church, we will make the improvements to the sound system. Any gifts designated "Building Fund" up to that point will go to these important building needs.

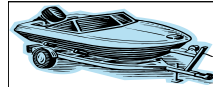
