True Love Waits

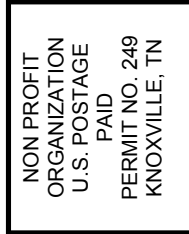
The Youth Department will be doing

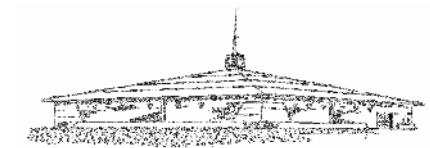
