Fireproof Class

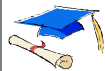
A 6-week "Fireproof" class began on Sunday, April 11. The class will meet for five more weeks. The study is being led by Gary & Kathy Cate.

Disaster Relief Training Opportunities

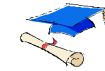

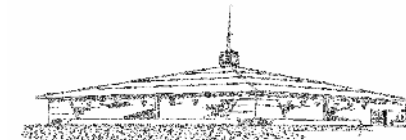
